Make plans to attend our 8th annual "Groovin' at the Grove" Fun Run, September 16.



Arrival and Dismissal

Here are some things you can do to help us keep things moving quickly and safely...

- Leave as LITTLE SPACE as POSSIBLE between your car and the car in front of you. This prevents us from having cars backed up on the road.
- Have your child get ready as soon as you turn into the parking lot and ready to open the door when you stop.
- Turn right when exiting the parking lot.



Back-to-School Anxiety is a common challenge, especially for grade school kids. Here are some helpful tips to help your child ease their nerves and have a successful school year.

- 1) CHECK IN WITH YOURSELF. Noticing and managing our own worries helps to avoid passing anxiety along to our children. Anxiety can be contagious.
- 2) LISTEN and PRAISE. Instead of dismissing your child's emotions (i.e., "You'll do great. There's nothing to worry about"), try to listen and acknowledge your child's feelings (i.e., "Tell me more. I know that's hard."). Also give praise for specific acts of bravery (i.e., "You felt scared to go to school and you did it anyways."). This encourages self-esteem and confidence.
- 3) LET SCHOOL STAFF KNOW. Reach out to teachers, aides, school psychologist and/or school nurse to communicate your child's anxiety about school. Strong parent-school staff relationships make all the difference for your child's social, emotional, and academic well-being.

ATTENDANCE-What to do if your child is absent or late to school.

When your child is absent please do the following:

- 1. Call the school @ 615-790-4720 or email the attendance secretary, Kristen Brown, at brownkri@fssd.org to let us know why your child is absent. This will prevent your child from being placed on the morning dialer.
- 2. When your child returns, please send a Dr. Note or a parent note that includes the student name, date(s) of absence, and the reason the child was absent. You have 7 school days to return this note.

Please keep in mind, a parent note does not necessarily excuse the absence but the documentation helps. For a list of approved absences please view the student handbook on our website.

We all have "those mornings" and sometimes run a bit behind. If the ladies who are outside at arrival have left their positions and the "Oops Sign" is you will need to park and walk your child into the office to sign to school.


