We now have AIMs data to share so you can see just how much growth our Kinder-1st grade students have made this year. These foundational years are so important and we are proud to share these results below:

AIMS Reading

Kinder Initial Sound 49% → 55%

1st Reading Accuracy 45% → 90%

AIMS Math

Kinder Quantity Fluency 47% → 75%

1st Fact Fluency $57\% \rightarrow 87\%$


